ENVIRONMENT AND SUSTAINABILITY

Derby County Community Trust is committed to empowering young people to take positive action around climate change. Our Rammie's Little Plotters programme has been designed for children aged 3 to 6 years old. The programme aims to foster children's connection with the natural world through activities like planting, harvesting, and learning about food growth.

We recognise the positive impact that nature connectivity and outdoor learning can have on children and their wellbeing. As such, we offer opportunities to develop a range of skills and attributes, as well as an understanding and connection to the outdoors. Our Forest School initiative has proved to be very popular with schools across Derby and our programmes delivered at our community allotments support a variety of participants of all ages.

We are excited to launch our Pride Park Litter Pick this year. This is our way of taking care of the environment on our doorstep and rallying a group of likeminded volunteers to come together as a group to tackle littering in our area.

STEM LEARNING

Derby is a hub for engineering and technology which provides realworld opportunities for young people in the area if we can help to ignite a passion for Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths early in their lives.

Our flagship programme, Rambots, has been designed to boost STEM learning in primary schools. The programme aims to engage pupils through fun, interactive coding challenges using Sphero BOLT robots. The 6-week programme introduces children to coding programmes including Draw, Block and Javascript and is suitable for both KS1 and KS2.

HOW WILL YOUR SUPPORT IMPACT OUR STEM LEARNING PROVISION?

Our ambition is to grow our STEM programme and deliver the Rambots programme to more students in Derby and Derbyshire. We would like to collaborate with likeminded organisations to inspire young people that by applying themselves to STEM subjects it will open them up to a host of worthwhile career opportunities.

HEALTH AND WELLBEING

Derby County Community Trust's Health department deliver targeted health intervention programmes aimed at reducing health inequalities and promoting healthy lifestyles to people living in Derbyshire.

All of our health programmes offer person centred, integrated and holistic approaches to improve the health and wellbeing of residents living in Derbyshire.

The health initiatives offer bespoke tailored support packages to individuals aged from 5 to 95 and incorporate needs-led physical activity, targeted work around long-term health conditions, informal learning and befriending service to reduce social isolation.

We work to achieve four key outcomes of supporting good health and wellbeing; developing more active communities; optimising life chances and building community pride.

SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL NEEDS AND DISABILITIES PROVISION

As part of the EFL Trust's 'Every Player Counts' campaign, we are committed to ensuring everyone can take part in sport regardless of any physical or mental disability.

Derby County Community Trust offer several pan-disability sessions to support all ages with taking part in physical activity. These sessions are for those who may have a physical disability or additional needs, including autism and ADHD. Our Shooters sessions provide similar opportunities for adults and take place weekly. Our players gain opportunities to represent Derby against other pan-disability squads in competitions and tournaments.

We also offer impairment specific sessions for individuals with certain disabilities. We deliver sessions for players with Down's syndrome, offer specific coaching for players with cerebral palsy and our visually impaired sessions provide the chance for partially sighted players to take part in football activities.

SCHOOLS EVENTS
