Derby County Community Trust are looking to recruit an experienced proactive individual to join the Health department as a Health Team Leader.

The successful candidate will lead and manage the children and young people's mental health offer within the Trust, across Derby and Derbyshire.

Previous experience managing a team is essential as the key to the success of the role is to manage a small team to implement a high-quality Early Intervention service to children and young people experiencing mild mental health difficulties. The service will include both school-based and community-based provision offering a universal and targeted programme to children and young people aged 5–17 years old.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- To coordinate the children and young people's mental wellbeing programme on behalf of the Trust.
- To produce comprehensive reports to the funding agency and provide feedback where requested.
- To support in strategic meetings and provide support to the Health and Wellbeing Manager.
- The ability to form strong working relationships with key partners to enhance the delivery of the programme and network effectively.
- To effectively plan and implement the programme through clear action planning and implementation of key milestones.
- To lead the development and implementation of an effective and robust process of quality assurance and data collection.
- The ability to interpret data effectively.
- To work in close partnership with the Active Schools manager around whole school approach to improving the physical, emotional and mental health of children and young people.
- To ensure the Winning Minds Transition programme is embedded within the curriculum by training teachers to deliver the programme.

- To have a sound understanding and in-depth knowledge of children and young people's mental and emotional health and wellbeing.
- Demonstrate a sound understanding of partnership working in relation to children and young people's mental and emotional health and wellbeing.
- To develop clear pathways across the partnership for cross referral of children and young people.
- In addition to school-based sessions, to develop community-based hubs.
- Ability to work in both primary and secondary school settings.

PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS AND EXPERIENCE

- Degree level or above qualification, in field of children's health would be desirable.
- At least one year experience in project coordination.
- At least two years' experience of working in the field of children and young people's mental health.
- Experience of partnership working.
- Experience of producing comprehensive reports to funders and external agencies.
- Knowledge of local landscape and environment around mental health and wellbeing.
- A sound understanding of safeguarding and reporting.
- Effective communicator, both verbally and written.
- Ability to write comprehensive reports.
- Ability to handle multiple priorities and use own initiative to problem solve.
- Experience of working with primary and secondary age children and young people would be desirable.
- The ability to interpret data collected through the programme would be desirable.
- An understanding of the benefit of a whole school approach would be desirable.
