Derby County Community Trust have an exciting opportunity to join the Female RTC as Under 14 Coach.

Derby County Community Trust have four teams within the RTC. The successful candidate will coach at under 14 female level and will be able to demonstrate the ability to design, deliver and

review coaching sessions in line with the clubs' curriculum.

The successful candidate will work closely with the Under 16 Head Coach and will enjoy working as part of a team, be enthusiastic, hardworking, and be flexible to the requirements of the position and the business.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Responsible for the planning and delivering the technical and tactical coaching programme for the u14 age group in line with the scheme of work.
- Coach and manage your team both home and away as applicable.
- To liaise with key RTC personnel when planning and arranging sessions to ensure the appropriate support is in place and all timed activities are age appropriate.
- Complete and email weekly session plans to the RTC director/education manager.
- To evaluate players from their training and playing process for effective feedback on their player review sessions.
- To conduct group, unit and individual analysis sessions where applicable.
- Assessment and feedback as required from the annual four session trial period to select 18 players.
- To liaise directly with the assistant coach on set plays, 1:1 coaching support and functional/conditioned practices to support and develop the players.
- Ensure appropriate playing opportunities for all contracted players.

- Make sure that the emphasis is on individual and team learning objectives during all phases of the match.
- Manage players to make sure they evaluate all matches with documented achievements and appropriate action plans.
- Develop appropriate set plays for attack and defence throughout the season.
- Exhibit touchline behaviour in accordance to FA staff guidelines.
- Help recruit players where applicable for the following season pending RTC licence.
- Keep correct and accurate records of any petty cash payments for referee or pitch fees in line with league sanctions.
- Monitor potential safeguarding children's risks and work with the designated Welfare officer through the correct policies and procedures.
