It's very manageable as I don't have any young children. So I do most work at home after work. I also feel supported by my manager and they have allowed me to do work whilst I am on night shifts. The main factor is that the training is very flexible which has enabled me to have a good balance.

Do you feel you've had support by both your manager and your trainers?

My trainers have been excellent! Especially my functional skills tutor, they are always replying so quickly to questions and requests.

My manager has also been very supportive and when I've needed extra support or time to work on my course work, they've always been very understanding.

What advice would you give someone that is looking into starting their qualification?

Go ahead, do it! Look into it but don't leave it to the last minute as this is a great opportunity.
