Feeling good is also about looking good, that's why we have our own hairdressing salon, laundry and ironing services.




Meals can be enjoyed in your dining area or, if you'd prefer, in the privacy of your own room.

We choose dedicated staff for whom caring is not just a job but a vocation. Each and every member of staff receives first class training which continues throughout their professional career.


